Fieldwork Dates: 12th-14th January 2012

Data Collection Method: Two separate polls were conducted simultaneously using the Toluna/Survation online consumer panel. Differential response rates from different demographic groups were taken into account.

Population Sampled: All adults aged 18+ in England, Scotland and Wales. One poll sampled adults resident in Scotland whilst the other sampled adults resident in England and Wales.

Sample Size: Scotland Poll – 1001; England & Wales 1019

Data Weighting: Data were weighted to the profile of all adults aged 18+. Data were weighted by sex, age, socio-economic group, and region. Targets for the weighted data were derived from the National Readership Survey, a random probability survey comprising 36,000 random face-to-face interviews conducted annually, and the Office of National Statistics "Neighbourhood Statistics" website, which provides ward level demographic statistics derived from the 2001 UK Census.

As this was a political poll the data were also past voted weighted using the 2010 General Election as a control.

Voting Intention: In addition to the demographic weighting the Voting Intention figure is further weighted by likelihood to vote and then adjusted to account for past vote behaviour.

Respondents are asked how likely they are to vote on a scale of 0 to 10 and this figure is used to assign a weight to each case. So if a respondent answered 10 out of 10 they are assigned a weight of 1 in the voting intention question; if they answered 9/10 they are weighted 0.9; and so on. If a respondent told us they would not vote (0/10) then they are assigned a weight of 0 and effectively excluded from the voting intention data.

We take into account past voting behaviour in two ways. If a respondent did NOT vote in the 2010 General Election their likelihood to vote weight is halved. So if they did not vote in 2010 and answered 10 out of 10 to the likelihood to vote question they are assigned a weight of 0.5; if they answered 9/10 they are weighted 0.45; and so on.

Finally, if a respondent either refused to answer the voting intention question or said they were currently undecided who they would vote for we take into account who they voted for in the 2010 General Election. If they did answer this question then we adjust the voting intention figures by adding a third of the undecideds and refused to the parties they voted for in the 2010 General Election.

As well as prompting the Conservatives, Labour and the Liberal Democrats in the voting intention question Survation also include significant minor parties depending on which country the respondent lives in. So, in Scotland the Scottish National Party are prompted along with the three main parties, as are Plaid Cymru in Wales and the United Kingdom Independence Party (UKIP) in England.
