# Methodology

#### **Fieldwork Dates**

2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2014

#### **Data Collection Method**

The survey was conducted via telephone. A combination of random numbers seeded from the complete BT directory of households in the local wards and, in addition, a smaller amount of targeted lifestyle data for specific age brackets were called

#### **Population Sampled**

All residents aged 18+ in the Newark constituency

#### Sample Size

678

#### **Data Weighting**

Data were weighted to the profile of all adults aged 18+. Data were weighted by age, sex, region and likelihood to vote. Targets for the weighted data were derived from Office of National Statistics 2011 Census data.

As an additional weighting step, in order to enable comparisons with other published polling in Newark, a voting intentions table was produced which included weighting by 2010 vote (Table 6) and one which included a reallocation of a 0.5 factor of undecided and refused responses by their vote in the 2010 general election (Table 7). As these steps do not form part of our standard constituency polling methodology, they do not form part of our published headline figures, which can be found in Table 5. However, they will be comparable with the Ashcroft Polling headline results published on 2<sup>nd</sup> June.

#### **Margin of Error**

Because only a sample of the full population was interviewed, all results are subject to margin of error, meaning that not all differences are statistically significant. For example, in a question where 50% (the worst case scenario as far as margin of error is concerned) gave a particular answer, with a sample of 678 it is 95% certain that the 'true' value will fall within the range of 3.7% from the sample result. Subsamples from the cross-breaks will be subject to higher margin of error, conclusions drawn from crossbreaks with very small sub-samples should be treated with caution.

#### **Voting Intention**

In order to assess voting intention, we first asked respondents how likely they would be to vote in the Newark by-election next week on a scale of 0-10. This likelihood to vote for was then used to weight voters' responses, such that respondents replying "10" were weighted by a factor of 1.0, whilst those responding "9" were weighted by a factor of 0.9, and so on down to responses of "0" being excluded altogether.

Respondents were then asked who they would be most likely to vote for in the Newark by-election, with the responses "Michael Payne – Labour", "Robert Jenrick – Conservative", "David Watts – Liberal Democrat", "Roger Helmer – UKIP" and "Some other candidate" prompted in a randomising order. A full list of other candidates was read if the respondent said 'some other candidate'.



#### **Question presentation**

All data tables shown in full below, in order and wording put to respondents, including but not limited to all tables relating to published data and all relevant tables preceding them. Tables for demographic questions might not be included but these should be clear from the cross-breaks on published tables. In all questions where the responses are a list of parties, names or statements, these will typically have been displayed to respondents in a randomising order. The only questions which would not have had randomising responses would be those in which there was a natural order to maintain – e.g. a scale from "strongly agree" to "strongly disagree", a list of numbers from 0 to 10 or questions which had factual rather than opinion-related answers such as demographic information. "Other", "Don't know" and "Refused" responses are not randomised.

Not all questions will have necessarily been asked to all respondents – this is because they may be follow-on questions from previous questions or only appropriate to certain demographic groups. Lower response counts should make clear where this has occurred.
