Methodology

Fieldwork Dates

16th - 17th September 2014

Data Collection Method

The survey was conducted telephone. The telephone poll was a systematic random sample of mobiles and landlines, ordered by key strata to reflect the eligible Scottish population. These strata were, age, sex, local authority, income and employment status.

Population Sampled

All residents aged 16+ in Scotland

Sample Size

1266 individual responses 1061 effective responses

Sampling Method

Though the poll managed to reach 1,266 respondents, it has an effective sample size of 1061. This is due to the sampling strategy employed, which aimed to mitigate some of the biases associated with contacting respondents via landlines. After interview, households (landline respondents) with multiple eligible occupants were asked for a second response within the household. A Kish Grid was used to assign the eligible participant at random. Respondents from those households that responded twice were accounted for appropriately in the weighting strategy by applying a factor of 0.5 to both respondents' weights. Mobile respondents were not asked for a second response.

Data Weighting

Data were weighted to the profile of all adults aged 16+. Data were weighted by age, sex, region and past vote. Weighting targets were derived from ONS 2011 Census data for Scotland and the results of the 2011 Holyrood election

Margin of Error

Because only a sample of the full population was interviewed, all results are subject to margin of error, meaning that not all differences are statistically significant. For example, in a question where 50% (the worst case scenario as far as margin of error is concerned) gave a particular answer, with an effective sample size of 1061 it is 95% certain that the 'true' value will fall within the range of 3.1% from the sample result. Subsamples from the cross–breaks will be subject to higher margin of error, conclusions drawn from crossbreaks with very small sub–samples should be treated with caution.

Voting Intention

In order to assess voting intention, we first asked respondents how likely they would be to vote in the next election on a scale of 0-10. This likelihood to vote for was then used to weight voters' responses, such that respondents replying "10" were weighted by a factor of 1.0, whilst those responding "9" were weighted by a factor of 0.9, and so on down to responses of "0" being excluded altogether.



Question presentation

All data tables shown in full below, in order and wording put to respondents, including but not limited to all tables relating to published data and all relevant tables preceding them. Tables for demographic questions might not be included but these should be clear from the cross-breaks on published tables. In all questions where the responses are a list of parties, names or statements, these will typically have been displayed to respondents in a randomising order. The only questions which would not have had randomising responses would be those in which there was a natural order to maintain – e.g. a scale from "strongly agree" to "strongly disagree", a list of numbers from 0 to 10 or questions which had factual rather than opinion-related answers such as demographic information. "Other", "Don't know" and "Refused" responses are not randomised.

Not all questions will have necessarily been asked to all respondents – this is because they may be follow-on questions from previous questions or only appropriate to certain demographic groups. Lower response counts should make clear where this has occurred.
