## Fieldwork Dates

3rd - 6th November 2014

## Data Collection Method

The survey was conducted via online panel. Invitations to complete surveys were sent out to members of the panel.

## Population Sampled

All residents aged 18+ in the UK, who either attend football matches or watch football on TV

## Data Sampling / Weighting

As there is no known demographic profile of football supporters per se, data is unweighted. However, sample was drawn randomly from a demographically representative panel of UK adults who were asked filter questions to identify if they were football supporters.

## Margin of Error

Because only a sample of the full population was interviewed, all results are subject to margin of error, meaning that not all differences are statistically significant. For example, in a question where $50 \%$ (the worst case scenario as far as margin of error is concerned) gave a particular answer, with a sample of 1,000 it is $95 \%$ certain that the 'true' value will fall within the range of $3.1 \%$ from the sample result. Subsamples from the cross-breaks will be subject to higher margin of error, conclusions drawn from crossbreaks with very small sub-samples should be treated with caution.

## Question presentation

All data tables shown in full below, in order and wording put to respondents, including but not limited to all tables relating to published data and all relevant tables preceding them. Tables for demographic questions might not be included but these should be clear from the cross-breaks on published tables. In all questions where the responses are a list of parties, names or statements, these will typically have been displayed to respondents in a randomising order. The only questions which would not have had randomising responses would be those in which there was a natural order to maintain - e.g. a scale from "strongly agree" to "strongly disagree", a list of numbers from 0 to 10 or questions which had factual rather than opinionrelated answers such as demographic information. "Other", "Don't know" and "Refused" responses are not randomised.

Not all questions will have necessarily been asked to all respondents - this is because they may be follow-on questions from previous questions or only appropriate to certain demographic groups. Lower response counts should make clear where this has occurred
